Operation under COVID-19 restrictions

To enable members to rehearse together while minimising the risk of transmission of infection the NCO has formulated the following set of rules. These apply for rehearsals at the Ainslie Arts Centre Main Hall commencing 21 February 2022. Limits on room capacity and the wearing of masks will be determined by the ACT Government's COVID-19 restrictions that apply at the time of each rehearsal.

1. Members must comply with all ACT Government requirements, restrictions and advice in relation to COVID-19.
2. Members attending a rehearsal must register by the Sunday before the rehearsal. The NCO will provide a link for this. You will need to enter your contact details.
3. Please do not attend if you have any symptoms suggesting an infection, if you are awaiting the results of a COVID-19 test or if you have been directed by Government health authorities to quarantine or self- isolate.
4. If a member shows symptoms while attending a rehearsal, they will be asked respectfully to leave. If asked to leave they will equally respectfully do so.
5. We have been requested to ensure that all members enter the Ainslie Arts Centre by the front door. The back door is for the entry of large instruments only. You will be provided with a code for the keypad. Make your way down the corridor and on entering the rehearsal hall ensure that your attendance is noted on the list at the door. Use the hand sanitiser provided.
6. Please avoid physical contact with other orchestra members and maintain spacing in accordance with the applicable COVID-19 restrictions. Face masks must be worn if required by the ACT Government's COVID-19 restrictions.
7. The session will be from 7:30 to 9:30 pm with a short break halfway through the period. Please bring your own water bottle or other sustenance. There will not be any refreshments provided.
